HOW TO GET THERE?

ACCESS BY PLANE

Corfu International Airport (CFU): The airport is 8km from the base, which is a 20-minute journey by car/shuttle. There are regular flights from Athens with Olympic Airlines and Aegean Airlines. Please check the schedule on the airport website.

TRANSFERS FROM THE AIRPORT TO OUR BASE

If you need organized transfer from the airport, please contact your aftersales team. Major car rental companies operate from the airport, please refer to airport website for info, working hours and contacts. Taxis are regularly available in front of the airport buildings.



ACCESS BY ROAD

Taxis are available at the airport. They charge 25€. Transfer can be arranged by the base for taxis, mini buses or buses.

ACCESS BY BUS

There is a bus that leaves from the airport to downtown and, from there, bus number 7 stops outside of the marina. Walking distance from the bus stop to the base is 1km.

LOCAL AREA INTRODUCTION

A yacht charter in Corfu gives you access to the gateway to the Ionian Islands on the western side of mainland Greece. Sail the seven main islands of this archipelago, as well as its smaller islands, and enjoy fertile landscapes with plentiful olive groves, clear blue waters for snorkeling

and a mixture of different civilizations and cultures that harmoniously meld together.

Our base on the scenic Ionian island of Corfu is located at Gouvia Marina. Corfu is the northernmost and most popular Ionian island due to its stunning beaches and natural settings, a

distinctive history, intriguing architectural and archaeological remains.

Start your Corfu sailing vacation exploring the compact, walkable old town, a cultural UNESCO

World Heritage Site built between two Venetian fortresses. There is plenty to do here including

touring the forts and the Archaeological Museum, in addition to the extensive selection of shops

and restaurants.

SAILING CONDITIONS

Depart from our base at Gouvia Marina on beautiful Corfu, the most popular of the Ionian islands due to the stunning beaches, rugged mountains and intriguing archaeological sites. Your skipper will show you the best of the Ionian islands off the Northwestern shores of Greece, with their warm clear waters, scenic ports of call, sheltered bays and delightful local tavernas.

By day, enjoy breakfast and lunch onboard; while sailing between islands in the company of like-minded travelers, stopping for swimming, paddle boarding, and sightseeing along the way. Upon arrival at your evening anchorage, seek out delightful local restaurants offering an array of traditional food and drink.

WEATHER

The best months for a Corfu sailing vacation is in the summer when the weather is hot, sunny and dry. July and August are the hottest months in Corfu with an average high of 88°F and a sea temperature of 75-77°F. June is a good month to visit as there are fewer crowds and yet the weather is warm.

Spring sailing is pleasant with temperatures reaching 75-82°F in April and May, although the sea doesn't start to heat up until June with 72°F. During the fall, temperatures are still good averaging 82-73°F and the sea temperatures are still around 75°F.

TEMPERATURE

Climate in Corfu:

Summer High: The July high is around 88°F

Winter Low: The January low is 50°F

WHAT TO PACK

- Soft luggage that you can fold away or roll up hard suitcases are hard to fit in your cabin and there is nowhere to store them onboard
- Reef-friendly sunblock and sun cream
- Dry bags or zip lock bags to protect your money, cameras and mobiles
- Seasickness bands and tablets are good for novice sailors
- Earplugs and eyeshades are great for light sleepers
- Keep clothing light and remember you will be around water a lot! Don't forget several swimsuits, hat, sunglasses and an extra beach towel (even though towels are provided)



- When it comes to shoes, you're likely to be barefoot onboard so pack just one pair for going ashore and some water shoes for reefs
- Leave expensive jewelry, make-up and hair straighteners behind it's time to relax!
